Cyclists will enjoy the beautiful, rolling hills surrounding Maysville and Mason County on their curvy, little traveled back roads. In 2023 four routes will be offered including a challenging century, metric century or the 40 and 22 mile loops. Routes are fully supported with surprise themes at the SAG stops staffed by community volunteers. After a fun and challenging day on the road, cyclists can expect to listen to some local music talent or take advantage of special offers at a few local eateries. It is definitely some of the best cycling in Northern Kentucky, and not to be missed!
